CHANGES / CLARIFICATIONS TO BID DOCUMENTATION

- 1. The city is handling the site work, erosion controls, and seed and straw. If an area is completed and has established grass, then it will be up to contractor to repair.
- 2. The site has been completed to the building pad gravel. Work from this bid is to proceed from there.
- 3. Contractor responsible for installing and maintaining their own concrete wash-out pit.

CHANGES TO MECHANICAL, ELECTRICAL, LIGHTING AND PLUMBING

- 1. The owner will have all utilities brought to the building and connected. This project is to include all items after the utility connection.
- 2. Sprinkler supplier to include all items required for a complete system, including but not limited to the sprinkler pit and valves. The city will have connection made from the pit to the street tap.
- 3. The specifications for the sprinkler call for a wet system but the "Covered Parking: Room 126" is an unconditioned space. Bidders are to include a dry system of their design that will cover this area per code. This could be a dry system or anti-freeze extended heads, whichever way can be designed.
- 4. The fire control access panel is to be located in the mechanical room located on the mezzanine. The other location in the bay is to be omitted.



5. There appeared to be some confusion on the radiant heaters. Radiant heaters are to be 100,000 BTU/HR rated as per the legend on sheet M2.00. The units are to be approximately 45' in length, each, with the final length per manufacturer's specifications.

CHANGES / CLARIFICATIONS TO SPECIFICATIONS

1. Omit "Section 01001 TAX EXEMPT PROJECT" that says taxes are excluded from this project. This project is to include all federal, state and local taxes on all materials used on this project.
